**Helping your kids with online classes and schoolwork**

**Join forces with other parents.** Reach out safely or via phone, email, or social media and exchange tips for keeping kids focused and engaged.

**Connect with your child's teacher.** Remember, they're also getting through this by trial and error. If your child's school is still closed, be honest about what is working with home tutoring and what isn't. Your child's teacher has

a good understanding of their academic strengths and weaknesses, so they may be able to help you come up with a more individualized learning plan.

**Create a learning routine.** A routine gives kids a sense of normalcy during an otherwise uncertain time. But you don't have to go crazy with color-coded schedules if that's not your style. Just create a general outline that you think you can maintain on most days that still leaves room for flexibility and downtime.

**Set goals—and celebrate their completion.** Since so much has been stripped from our everyday lives, having something to look forward to can help kids stay motivated. Setting up small rewards, like watching an episode of a favorite TV show, can help them tackle that unpleasant math assignment. Get the whole family in on it. If you all set a few goals and plan breaks together, your kids will see that you're a team.

**Get creative with lessons.** Doing a science experiment, for example, or cooking with measurements, can be a good way of bringing lessons to life.
