REVIVING CHILDREN'S LIFE SKILLS IN THE POST PANDEMIC ERA

"EVERYTHING WE TEACH SHOULD BE DIFFERENT FROM MACHINES. IF WE DO NOT CHANGE THE WAY WE TEACH, 30 YEARS FROM NOW WE WILL BE IN REAL TROUBLE. WE NEED TO TEACH OUR CHILDREN VALUES, BELIEVING, INDEPENDENT THINKING, TEAMWORK, CARE FOR OTHERS. THESE ARE SOFT SKILLS THAT CONVENTIONAL KNOWLEDGE WILL NOT TEACH YOU"

CHILDREN ARE TRICKLING BACK T SCHOOLS AFTER PROLONGED LOCKDOWNS. GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS ARE TAKING UP VARIOUS MEASURES TO BRING BACK SCHOOLING SYSTEM TO NORMALCY AS IT USED TO BE OF COURSE WITH THE COVID 19 PROTOCOLS IN PLACE. ACCORDING TO GOVERNMENT STUDIES ON EDUCATION, COVID HAS SEVERELY AFFECTED THE EDUCATION OF 320 MILLION CHILDREN AND YOUTH IN THE COUNTRY. ACADEMIC LEARNING LOSS OF PRIMARY SECONDARY CHILDREN IS ESTIMATED AT 80-90 PERCENT. YET BEYOND ACADEMIC LOSS THE PANDEMIC HAS EXTRACTED A HEAVY TOLL IN TERMS OF LOSS OF LIFE SKILLS LEARNING. THE PROLONGED LOCKDOWN HAS SEVERELY DAMAGED THE COMMUNICATION, LISTENING, EMPATHY, COLLABORATION, CONVERSATIONAL SKILLS OF OUR CHILDREN THIS LOSS HAS COMPOUNDED THE LOSS OF ACADEMIC EDUCATION.

THE LOSS OF ACADEMIC EDUCATION CAN BE MADE GOOD IN TIME BY CAREFULLY PLANNED STRATEGIC MEASURES BY THE SCHOOLS AND THE GOVERNMENT. BUT THE LOSS OF Co ACADEMIC EDUCATION AND SOCIO EMOTIONAL LEARNING NECESSARY FOR THE LIFELONG GROWTH OF THE CHILDREN'S FOUR FUNDAMENTAL FACULTIES MIND, BODY, HEART AND SOUL CAN ONLY BE COMPENSATED BY THE COMBINED EFFORTS OF ALL STAKEHOLDERS. EVEN PRIOR TO THE PANDEMIC, EXPERTS HAVE SUGGESTED THAT LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION SHOULD GO HAND IN HAND WITH ACADEMICS TO ENABLE OUR CHILDREN TO SUCCEED IN POST-PANDEMIC WORKPLACES. PARENTS AND EDUCATORS NEEDED TO FOCUS ON DEVELOPING STUDENTS' LIFE SKILLS EVEN AS THEY FOCUS ON REMEDIAL ACADEMIC EDUCATION IN THE POST-PANDEMIC ERA.

TO DEVELOP CHILDREN'S SOFT SKILLS IT'S IMPORTANT TO PROMOTE FAMILY ACTIVITIES. WHILE READING, WATCHING MOVIES, WORKING OUT, COOKING TOGETHER, PARENTS CAN PASS ON GOOD MANNERS, COOPERATION, THE LISTENING HABIT AND POLITE CONVERSATIONAL SKILLS TO CHILDREN. IN ADDITION, THE VIRTUES OF PERSEVERANCE, TIME MANAGEMENT AND QUICK DECISION-MAKING CAN BE SUBTLY PASSED TO CHILDREN WHILE THE FAMILY IS ENGAGED IN ENJOYABLE ACTIVITIES. THE POST-PANDEMIC ERA IS AN APPROPRIATE TIME FOR PARENTS AND TEACHERS TO STEP UP AND PROVIDE CHILDREN THE SOCIO-EMOTIONAL SUPPORT TO DEVELOP CHARACTER AND ETHICAL VALUES.

PARENTS CAN START BY SETTING CHILDREN EASILY ACHIEVABLE GOALS SUCH AS ASSIGNING THEM THE TASK OF PLANNING THE NEXT FAMILY HOLIDAY, ORGANISING A FEST/EVENT IN YOUR HOUSING COMMUNITY ETC. TEACHERS ALSO CAN ALSO ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO SET EASILY ACHIEVABLE ACADEMIC AND CO ACADEMIC GOALS. THIS WILL PREPARE THEM TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY AND MAKE ORDERLY DECISIONS LATER IN LIFE. CHILDREN CAN BECOME PART OF REAL LIFE PROJECTS IN THEIR HOMES AND ALSO SUCH SIMULATIONS IN THEIR SCHOOLS LIKE COOKING, BAKING ,DESIGNING, MARKETING ETC.

PUBLIC SPEAKING IS A VALUABLE LIFE SKILL THAT HELPS CHILDREN TO OVERCOME STAGE FRIGHT, THINK QUICKLY ON THEIR FEET, TO PUT FORWARD PERSUASIVE ARGUMENTS AND EXPRESS OPINIONS. IT DEVELOPS CHILDREN'S SELF-ESTEEM, CONFIDENCE, AND LEADERSHIP. OPPORTUNITIES TO SPEAK IN PUBLIC CAN BE CREATED IN FAMILY GET TOGETHERS AND IN SCHOOLS DURING CLUB ACTIVITIES AND SCHOOL FUNCTIONS. EDUCATORS ARE UNANIMOUS THAT DEVELOPING CRITICAL THINKING SKILLS — CAPABILITY TO QUESTION, INTERPRET, ANALYSE, COMPARE, CONTRAST, AND DRAW INFERENCES, IS IMPERATIVE FOR SUCCESS IN THE ACADEMY AND WORKPLACES.

ENCOURAGE CHILDREN TO PLAY MIND GAMES — TANGRAM, SUDOKU, MATCHSTICK PUZZLES AND CROSSWORDS — THAT PROMPT THEM TO THINK HARD, TO ASK HOW, WHERE, WHEN AND WHAT QUESTIONS, AND SEARCH FOR SOLUTIONS. MIND GAMES PROMPT CHILDREN TO DEVELOP CRITICAL THINKING, LOGIC AND REASONING SKILLS.

LISTENING STRATEGIES

There are many strategies that students can apply to help them understand before, during and after listening. Here are our top 10.

1. PREDICT

Before listening, think about what you know about the topic. What does the title suggest to you? What is the context for the listening?



6. VOCABULARY

What words do you know related to the topic? List to them and listen for them.

2. FOCUS

While listening don't try to understand every word. Focus on the general meaning of the speaker. The gist.

7. NOTES

If possible, jot down notes while listening. It will help you remember and retain information

3. RELAX

Nervousness will inhibit your listening activity. Relax, let the words and meaning flow into you and through you.

8. REFLECT

After listening, think about the topic and what was said. Did you get the main meaning and important points?

4. COMPARE

Before listening, you made some predictions. Remember those and compare. Were they Correct?

9. REVIEW

Take a look over your notes. Did you catch everything, the main points spoken?

5. REPEAT

If you really didn't understand the main points, listen again. Focus on what you may have missed. Or ask the speaker to repeat what she said.

10. ASSESS

Still having problems catching the meaning of the speaker? Note your main problems and work on a solution to improve.

TO DEVELOP INTO GOOD LISTENERS AND COMMUNICATORS, IT'S IMPORTANT FOR CHILDREN TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN ASSERTIVENESS AND AGGRESSION. WHEN A CHILD STATES HER WISHES DIRECTLY AND HONESTLY, WHILE TAKING OTHERS' NEEDS INTO ACCOUNT, SHE IS BEING ASSERTIVE.

AGGRESSION IS TO STAND UP FOR YOURSELF IN WAYS THAT VIOLATE THE RIGHTS OF OTHERS. AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOUR IS TYPICALLY ANTAGONISTIC, BLAMING, AND DEMANDING. IT INVOLVES THREATS, NAME-CALLING, AND CAN LEAD TO PHYSICAL FIGHTS. PARENTS NEED TO TEACH CHILDREN TO BE ASSERTIVE WITHOUT BEING AGGRESSIVE

AN INSPIRING LEADER & VISIONARY



Dr. Kurien was born to a **Syrian Christian family** on **26th November 1921** at Kozhikode, Kerala. As a child, Father of White Revolution **never liked milk** and had no plans of entering dairy industry.

After his graduation in Physics from Loyola College in Madras, he went on to pursue his Master's in **Mechanical Engineering from the USA** on government scholarship. Upon his return from the USA he had to work in Anand as an **Officer of the Diary Division** in return for the scholarship paid by the government.

In the year 1970, he laid the foundation for the world's largest diary development programme named **Operation Flood** which led to the White Revolution. Owing to this revolution, 72000 Indian villages could become milk producers.

Dr. Verghese Kurien was the mastermind behind the creation and tremendous success of **Amul**, the largest brand for dairy products in India.

Shyam Benegal directed '**Manthan**', starring **Smita Patil**, is a story based on the milk co-operative movement in India. This movie was entirely funded by Kurien's farmers. When Benegal was unable to get funds for this film, it was Kurien's farmers that contributed Rs. 2 each.

For his unparalleled contribution to the nation, Kurien has been honoured with several prestigious awards such as **Padma Shri, Ramon Magsaysay, Padma Bhushan and even Padma Vibhushan** (the highest civilian award). In the year 1965, Dr. Kurien was awarded an **honorary degree by the Michigan State University**.

He authored the book '**I Too Had a Dream**', which is an inspiring story about building milk co-operatives and farmer empowerment across the nation.

After a brief spell of illness, Dr. Kurien left this world at Nadiad when he was **90 years** old.

Owing to his invaluable contribution towards the dairy industry of India, his birth anniversary (26th November) is observed as **National Milk Day**. This architect of India's White Revolution will always be remembered as it was his contributions that catapulted India as the largest milk producer across the globe.

மதுரை (Madurai), இந்தியாவின், தமிழ்நாடு மாநிலத்தில் அமைந்துள்ள ஒரு தொன்மையான நகரம் ஆகும். இது, மதுரை மாவட்டத்தின் தலைநகர் ஆகும். தமிழ்நாட்டில் உள்ள பெருநகரங்களில், இதுவும் ஒன்றாகும். இது தமிழ்நாட்டில் சென்னை, கோயம்புத்தூர், திருச்சிராப்பள்ளிக்கு அடுத்த நகர்புற பரப்பளவு அடிப்படையில், நான்காவது பெரிய நகரமும் ஆகும். இந்நகரம், மக்கள்தொகை அடிப்படையில், தமிழகத்தின் மூன்றாவது பெரிய நகரமாகும். இந்தியாவில், பத்து இலட்சத்துக்கு மேல் மக்கட்தொகை கொண்ட இந்திய மாநகரங்களின் பட்டியலில், இது 44 ஆவது பெரிய நகரம் ஆகும்! வைகை ஆற்றங்கரையில் அமைந்துள்ள மதுரை நகரம், இங்கு அமைந்துள்ள மீனாட்சியம்மன் கோவிலுக்காக அதிகம் அறியப்படுகிறது. நகரின் உள்ளாட்சி நிர்வாகம் மதுரை மாநகராட்சி மூலம் மேற்கொள்ளப்படுகிறது.

இந்தியத் துணைக்கண்டத்தில், தொன்மையான வரலாற்றைக் கொண்ட மதுரை நகரம், சுமார் 2500 ஆண்டுகள் பழமையான, தொடர்ந்து மக்கள் வசித்து வரும் உலகின் சில நகரங்களுள் ஒன்று. பாண்டிய மன்னர்களின் தலைமையிடமாக விளங்கிய மதுரை, தமிழ் மொழியுடன் நெருங்கிய தொடர்புடையது. சங்க காலம் எனக் குறிக்கப்படும் கி.மு. 4 ஆம் நூற்றாண்டு முதல் கி.பி. 2 ஆம் நூற்றாண்டு வரையிலான காலத்தில், தமிழ் மொழி அறிஞர்களைக் கொண்டு மூன்றாம் தமிழ்ச் சங்கம் அமைக்கப்பட்டு, தமிழை வளர்த்த பெருமையுடைய நகரம் மதுரை!

INSPIRING YOUNG ACTIVIST



A child environmental activist from Manipur, India, 10-year old Licypriya Kangujam is among the youngest climate activists in the world. Often referred to as the 'Indian Greta Thunberg', the young activist has worked towards raising climate awareness since the tender age of seven and drew national attention as she protested before the Indian Parliament house in 2019 in favour of the passing of the climate change law, drawing the attention of thousands across India. Since then, Kangujam has travelled around the world, attended several United Nations conferences, campaigned for the compulsory integration of climate change lessons in school syllabi and addressed 50 world leaders in a virtual Earth Day conference in 2020 to draw attention to the imminent climate crisis. The young climate change advocate has been honoured with multiple awards, some of which include the SDGs Ambassador Award 2019, the World Children Peace Prize 2019 and the Global Child Prodigy Award 2020.
