She continues, "It's the same with us. There will be similar times in your life when you're dropped, bruised, and muddied. Yet no matter what happens, you *never* lose your value."


Moral of the story:

A PASSIONATE VISIONARY

REWRITING THE LAWS OF NATURE



Albert Einstein is perhaps the most famous scientist of the 20th century. The prized physicist had **a profound impact on our understanding of the universe**, including basic concepts such as **time**, light and gravity.

Born in Germany in 1879, Einstein was slightly different than all the boys. His head was a little bigger and he hardly spoke a word, which led at least one housekeeper to label him "retarded." Little did she know, this "retarded" boy would eventually go on to reshape the world through his ideas.

By age 26, Einstein had obtained his PhD. The same year he published 4 important papers on topics ranging from the nature of light to mass-energy equivalence. While largely ignored at first, these papers would eventually make a tremendous contribution to the scientific community, including the famous E= MC2 equation for mass energy equivalence.

These papers also contained the seeds of Einstein's **Theory of Relativity**, one of the most revolutionary ideas in history. Although it's impossible to pinpoint exactly the nature of Einstein's brilliance, he had all of the characteristics of a genius.

He had a vivid imagination, questioned everything and found new ways of thinking about old problems. He also had an unrelenting work ethic that pushed him to action even on the day of his death, where he was reportedly working on a speech for a television program. The final picture of Einstein's office taken hours before his passing showed a man who was deeply consumed in his work right up until the very end.

In addition to his timeless quotes and deep sense of humour, Einstein is remembered for overcoming adversity. From physical setbacks as a young boy to spending two frustrating years looking for work as a teaching assistant after graduating, Einstein's life was filled with challenges.

His ability to keep a positive attitude and provoke creative thought experiments were at the centre of his genius. More than 60 years after his death, the world remembers not a man who spent years working at a patent office, but a man who changed the world.

Hospitality is nothing, looking after towards guests. Hospitality is present in all the cultures of India and hence it's a pan Indian thing. The way of hospitality may change but the concept of looking toward guests and welcoming them is same and a part of Indian culture. Aththi Devo Dhavah

In Tamil culture hospitality includes the way one treats a guest. By hospitality, even a foe can become a friend. There is a saying in Tamil – "The biggest misery or poverty in this world is when one cannot welcome his guests properly". So hospitality is very important concept in Indian culture.

Virundu means feast in Tamil and ombal means hospitality, thus Virudhombal means hospitality shown towards our guests. Hospitality can be both official welcoming or of a surprise one. In official welcoming first you invite your guest either through word or by invitation. Normally inviting a person through word is the best form and the first step of hospitality you show towards your guests.

Invitations can either be for a get together, marriage functions, or inviting for a festival like Pongal, Deepavali. Whether guests arrive or not, your home should always to ready to welcome guests. Sometimes relatives or guests may give a surprise visit. That's why the reason for 365 days of a year, kolam or rangoli is drawn in front of homes by women during every morning before 8.

The next step of hospitality involves welcoming them with the word "Vanakkam" along with a smile. Vanakkam means bowing down to your soul just like namaskaram in other languages. The next step of hospitality is colling your guests to come inside and making them sit down as they would have travelled for long. The most important way of greeting your guests is to provide them with a glass of water.

The next of hospitality includes having a conversation with your guests. They should not feel left out. Normally bevarges like coffee and tea are provided only in evening time. Guests should always accept the offering from them if they ignorned that these leads to create cracks with relations that can't be plastered. The main part of hospitality is the feast. It includes the delicaties on a Banana leaf. Normally a Tamil feast should contain 18 food item of this 18, half of these dishes should be prepared with vegetables.

Tamilnadu region grows a lot of vegetables and these vegetables dishes should contain porival and kootu and it should server towards the opposite side of your plantain leaf. The other items Rice, Sweet on other side.

Along with feast, Betel nuts are given for chewing. When one gets satisfied by the feast 75% of your hospitality is over. After this feast, guests are gifted with gifts. The traditional gift that is given to guests are Tamboolam.

The east step includes a lovely send off and guests are allowed to tell as "I will be back". "I will see you soon and I will come back".




