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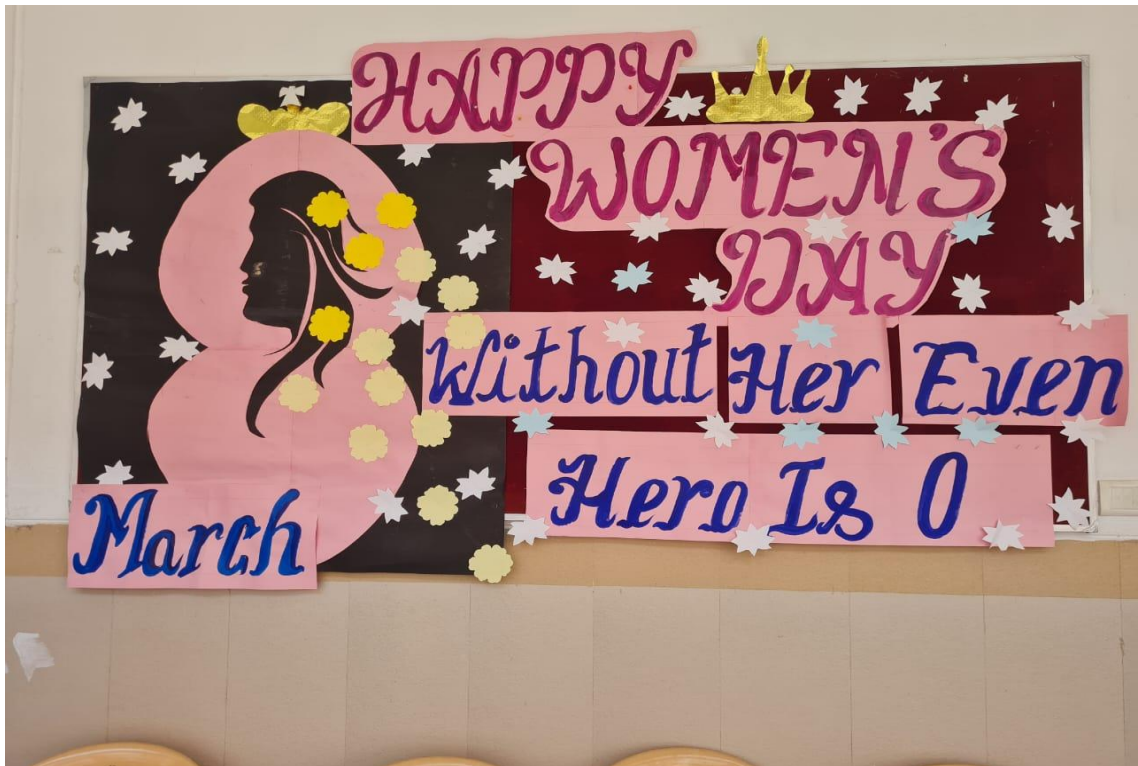

BEAT THE HEAT!!!

When the sun scorches down on our backs, mangoes and watermelons flood market and complaints about the weather become a pastime in most households, you know summer has arrived! With temperatures soaring we see a huge increase in cases of dehydrations.

It is extremely important to stay hydrated and safe in the heat by making simple life style changes.

Here are some tips to help you beat the heat:

Stay hydrated: For obvious reasons, this is the first tip we are going to address. It is common knowledge that hydration is key to getting through the summer. Dehydration is often seen in those who fail to consume fluids regularly. So how do we stay hydrated?

- Carry bottles of water wherever you go
- Try infused water or adding herbal, lemon to your water to make it interesting
- Ensure you also make the most of local drinks like buttermilk, tender coconut and fruit juice.
- Make sure each room in your house has a bottle of water
- If you are someone who easily forgets, set alarms to drink water

Make use of seasonal produce: Fruits and vegetables that are found in summer tend to have higher water content. This works in your favor by helping you get more fluids! Snack on water rich fruits and vegetables like watermelon and cucumber through the day. It's time to take full advantage of the seasonal produce in order to help us battle the summer heat.

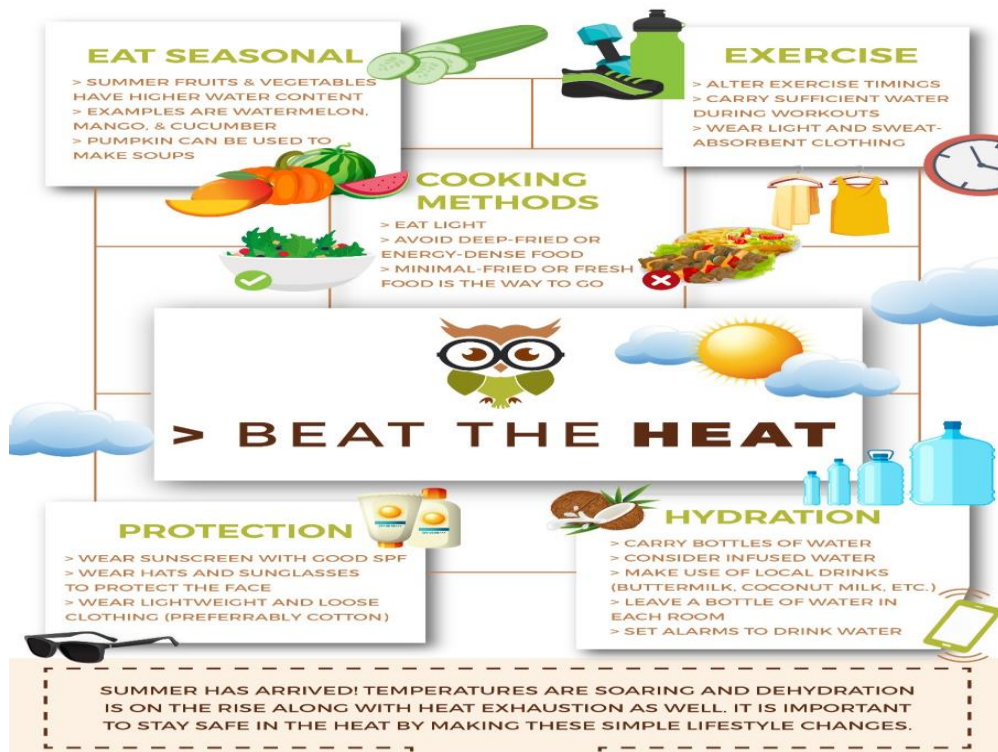
Cooking methods: During this period of intense heat, it is preferable to eat light meals. Deep fried food or food that is very energy dense and rich don't resonate with this season! Ice-creams are also a summer delicacy! Why not try and make popsicles out of fresh fruit at home? This is also an excellent way to ensure kids enjoy the summer too!

Exercise: It is very important to stay physically active all year around, but a common excuse to stop exercise during the summer is the heat. So what can be done? Try and alter your exercise timings, especially if it involves being outdoors. For example, if you go for a run at around 7 am and find it too hot, wake up around 6 and head out before the sun begins its job! Wow! But I can fetch the moon.**

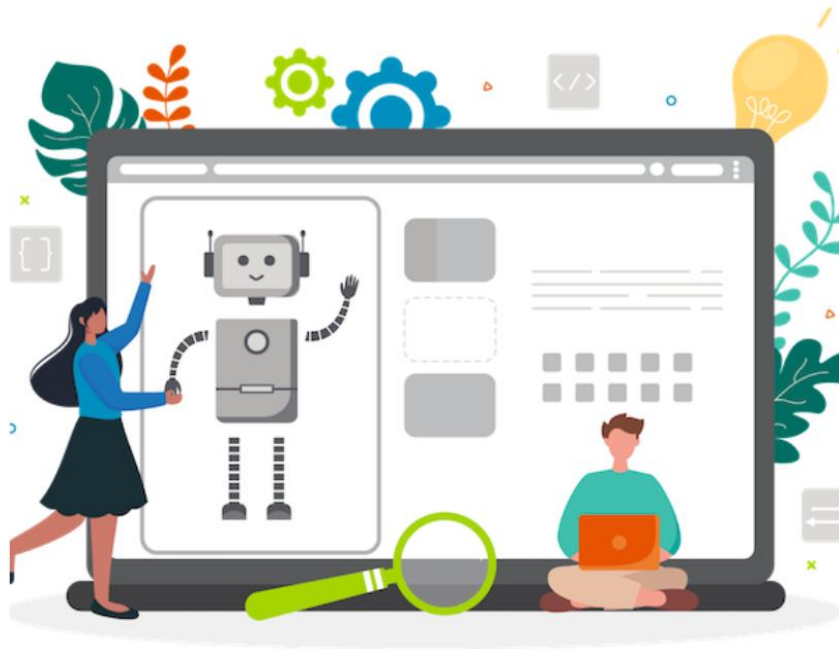

This report is comprised of the achievements made during the year gone by and at the same time set the path for greater accomplishments in the years to come.

Since its humble beginning in 2014 KMR has won the much acclaimed International School Award instituted by the British Council....and the current year has been no exception. We have done excellently well in academics and non-academic areas. At this juncture, we wish to put on record our sincere gratitude to the management, staff, students and the Parent Teacher Association for their kind support and guidance.

With great pleasure, we present the highlights of the academic year 2023-24:

The Grand Re-opening :

The staff along with the management welcomed the students and their parents into the new academic year 2023-24 which began on 3rd April, 2023.

The CBSE system of education in KMR, is a blend of theory and practice in the right proportion to arrive at a comprehensive curriculum. We achieved Academic Excellence by being responsible to the core.

Our Senior Student Abdur Rahman emerged as the topper in the grade 12 Public exam with 453 marks, closely followed by Prasanna and Dhivyavikashini. Our Grade 10 student Nithisa secured the first place with 483 marks, followed by Logeetha. Nithisa secured National rank with a centum in Tamil.

STAFF ENRICHMENT:

"It’s the teacher that makes the change, not the mere classroom".

With the sole purpose of updating teachers’ knowledge, the school hosted a series of Teachers’ Workshops. It was an attempt which inclusively engulfed various significant aspects like Meditation & Stress Management, English Language and Mathematics. M.I. KIDS workshops are conducted for teachers handling KG and grades 1 and 2. Apart from this, our teachers are made a part of the training sessions and workshops happening at other schools. Our teachers attended various workshops like CECRI workshop at Karaikudi. Our teachers have benefitted from CBSE Capacity Building workshops on Ethics and Values, Assessment strategies. Attendee teachers further share the knowledge with other fellow teachers widening the sphere of wisdom. Our Hindi teachers and English teachers got empowered by attending workshops conducted by Madhuban and Bharath Publications.

Regular staff meetings are conducted to evaluate our quality of performance and plan for the future with more innovative methods of teaching and learning programs. The state of the art labs with facilities meet world class standards. The tie-up with Bannari Amman Institute, Satyamangalam, to upscale the Math Lab grow from strength to strength with periodical visits of the same. Our tie-up with the prestigious Madurai Kamaraj University ensures that the necessary scientific backing is provided to the teaching fraternity. The Senior and Junior level Computer labs, Individual Physics, Chemistry, Biology Laboratories, English Laboratory with individual phonetic correction facility with a headphone for each, Montessori Lab, Social Science Lab are a testimony to the infrastructure facilities provided by our Management. Our tie-up with Bee Hive Academy of Virudhunagar enhances the English Language Skills of students. A communicative English trainer ensures that English is the first language of KMR.

Career_Guidance_and_Counselling:

Students are given orientation programmers and seminars in order to cope with the changing situation and equip them for the future with a strong value based foundation. Experts from counseling institutes like Balsu's academy, Presidency University provide the necessary support to our students. They help the students to meet the challenges of life. Career guidance Sessions are periodically organized for the students at the personal and professional level to choose the right career which is most important for their future.. Mr. Kalaimani, leading Career Guidance expert of South Tamilnadu, conducted a motivating and eye-opener session for the students and parents of grades 9 to 12. Road Safety Awareness program was conducted by the State Highways Department to instil the same in our students.

Examinations:

Periodical assessments and evaluations are conducted for the students and their progress are informed to the parents frequently in Parent Teacher Meetings. Parents are informed of the corrective measures to be taken in case they are not able to meet us in person.

Parent-Teacher-Association:

We have the strong support of our parents which we cherish every year. The PTA general body meeting is an occasion to acknowledge their service to the school. We conduct periodical meetings with the parents to discuss about the teaching learning process. Also Fridays are set apart for parent teacher interaction in which parents can walk-in to meet the teachers and the Principal.

Co-curricular-Activities:

We, at KMR International School not only focus on the intellectual development of our future generation, but also take care of their emotional and behavioral development in their early ages of development by inculcating sound moral values, responsibility and social awareness. We are doing it through different co-curricular activities and school celebrations.

School-Assemblies:

School Assemblies provide ample opportunities for all our students to come forth with self courage and express their abilities of public speaking, reading, thought sharing etc. Three language systems followed... Quiz is a regular feature. Monday's assemblies are the general assemblies. Thursdays we have the house-led assemblies. The four houses- Antarctic, Arctic, Atlantic and Pacific give their best during these assemblies. We have corridor assemblies on the week days with

an emphasis on self expression with an assembly topic for each day. Every day a successful personality is introduced to the children too.

STUDENTS COUNCIL:

Students Council was selected in a democratic way. Candidates presented their manifesto and canvassed votes too. The Principal and Senior level teachers chose the School Pupil Leader, Associate School Pupil Leader, Events Head and Sports Captain.

The members of the four houses- Antarctic, Arctic, Atlantic and Pacific, elected their Head Boy, Head Girl and Sports Captain from grade 11. The chosen students of grades 3-10 were posted as Prefects for the academic year. The students council members were bestowed with their responsibilities in the Investiture Ceremony presided by Mr. Sivakumar, the Sub Inspector of Nagamalai- Pudukottai Police Station.

KG:

A Montessori-based curriculum nurtures the young minds with utmost care. Our Montessori trained teachers backed with MI Kids and Orient Black Swan effectively graduate the tiny ones to the next level on Smart boards. The color days observed every month lifts the spirits of the entire school. The various days mentioned in the Almanac are strictly followed to make them get an insight of different proceedings around the world... Free transport facility for the Lower Kindergarten students lightens the hearts of parents.

PRIMARY LEVEL:

Subject enrichment activities are done by the students and teachers evaluate these as the internal assessment. Primary students take up projects appropriate to their age... Able software support from M.I. Kids makes the

classrooms techno-friendly. This year more Digital interactive panels were added to help teachers capture the world to enrich the classroom.

Middle level:

Middle level students shatter their stage fear by indulging in monthly forums. June month was assigned for English. August went to Social Science department as Freedom struggle and Independence were obviously highlighted. September was observed as Hindi mahina. October was terrifically Scientific. December is planned to be magically mathematical on December 22nd. January month goes to Tamil Department (Pongal marking culture as the main theme).Literary club, Math's club, Science club, reading club etc were merged with various departments to create a dedicated ambience and interest in students in particular areas where they have more interest. A ZERO period is followed every day, not as a tail ender, but as a mind- tickler. LSRW skill assessment and enhancement is the mainstay for this year.

An encyclopedic library has a soft and firm hold on the students pinning them as voracious readers. The Hindu has been subscribed for students from grades 3 to 12 as per the guidelines given by the renowned daily.

Extra-Curricular-Activities:

Keeping in view the all round development of the students extra-curricular activities are also given due importance. Archery, Chess, Carrom, Gymnastics, Karate, Silambam, Skating, Table tennis, Western dance, Carnatic Music are given place in the academic planning. Students of grades 1 to 8 choose their activities and get trained in various levels. Yoga is mandatory for all students starting from LKG. Scouts and Guides program shapes the students of grades 6,7, 8 as responsible citizens of India.

COMPETITIONS:

To take part is what counts in competition and lessons of victory and defeat are what we get in return. This environment was sufficiently created through inter-school, inter-house and inter-class competitions such as Elocution, Quiz, Creative-Writing, Spelling-Bee, Rhyme and Rhythm, Drawing and Power-Point competitions. Our students took part in various inter-school and zonal level Competitions and brought laudable laurels to the school. Talents week contests were a warm up for Madurai Sahodaya Contests.MSSC competitions, BUZZ Competitions, Aarohanam Competitions, Turning Point Contests are few examples.

EDUCATIONAL TRIPS:

Every student of the school is taken on a field trip which is purely educative.

KG students went around Madurai in 4 hours. Grades 1 to 9 explored Aquaria, Samanar Malai, Head Post Office, Keezhadi, Gandhi Museum, Black Forrest Bakers and the Tamil Sangam. The Hindu- Printing Press catered to the aspirations of the young journalists of Senior level.

Students of grades 6-12 were taken on an educational trip to Mysore and Bangalore.

Physical Education and Sports:

“To be a great champion you must believe you are the best, if you are not; keep on trying.” Sports competitions inculcate the spirit of positive challenges and sportsmanship among the students and prepare them for the life ahead. Sports, games and physical fitness occupy

a place of importance in our curriculum. The school has always been keen in taking initiative to get the best in sports arena. We are proud to say that we have two PET periods per week for all classes to keep ourselves as fit as a fiddle. This

makes our students effective event managers through Shramdhaan. Inter house sports competitions are organized at the school premises. The KMR-ians are taken out for different inter school events where they experience their sportsmanship. On 15th August, Yorker King, Mr. Natarajan's, honoured our Campus as Chief Guest for the Annual Sports Day. National Sports day was observed with fete and fervor. Our sport stars proved their Mettle in Madurai Sahodaya Sports Complex events in a wide range of events like Kabaddi, Handball, football, and athletics. We played perfect host for the Handball tournament. (Prize list is lengthy) This time our sport stars shined in Zonal meet too. We were amused to be part of our maiden cross country run which covered 5 km in and around Nagamalai- Pudukottai and KeelaKuilkudi. Effective team work with solid backing from the police department essayed a memorable day for KMR.

Khelo-India:

Teachers are given Fit India training and the regional games are played by teachers and students. Sports events are organised for both the teaching and non- teaching staff alongside students.

Health is Wealth:

Vaccination is stressed among the students and staff alike following the directions of the health department of Tamilnadu. Our staff members were taken to the nearby PHC as part of mass vaccination drive. Iron tablets are administered by us through the government. Periodical Dental check-up and Eye-check-ups keep our children health-smart. De-worming keeps our students parasite-free.

We stress on a healthy snack plan through-out the week to inculcate the habit of healthy food intake in the world of luring junk food. Peanut candies are expected

to be shared during birthday celebrations. National Milk Day is celebrated with a cup of milk.
