

Venue: KMR School Auditorium


Guest Lecturer: Dr. Rajeshwari

environment. Teachers left the workshop with a renewed sense of purpose and practical strategies to enhance leading engagement and proficiency among students.


Follow up work was given to the teachers to make action plan for reading practices.




