This is the concluding and oft quoted line of a famous sonnet penned by John Milton, a 17th-century historian, journalist and a poet born in London on December 9th, 1608. He is best known for his PARADISE LOST, considered as the greatest English epic poem. He was the most learned of the English poets. He was into religion and politics. Like Homer, the great Greek poet, he turned BLIND when he was in his middle age.

In his famous sonnet ON HIS BLINDNESS, which is almost an autobiographical poem, Milton expresses his feelings as a blind person. He says he will not be able to serve God because his sight is gone. But, as he proceeds towards the end of the poem, he understands that everyone has a role to play in this world regardless of their abilities and disabilities. People who are patient and waiting (like him) are as valuable to God as those who are always busy serving HIM. Milton reflects on how he can serve God despite his blindness that waiting faithfully is also an act of service.

Patience and endurance are also valuable contributions. Though it is a religious poem, its message has a universal appeal.

Physically and mentally challenged people need not wallow in self-pity and despair. Their disabilities do not in any way diminish their values to society.

## **"The Gettysburg Address: Lincoln's Vision of Unity and Democracy"**

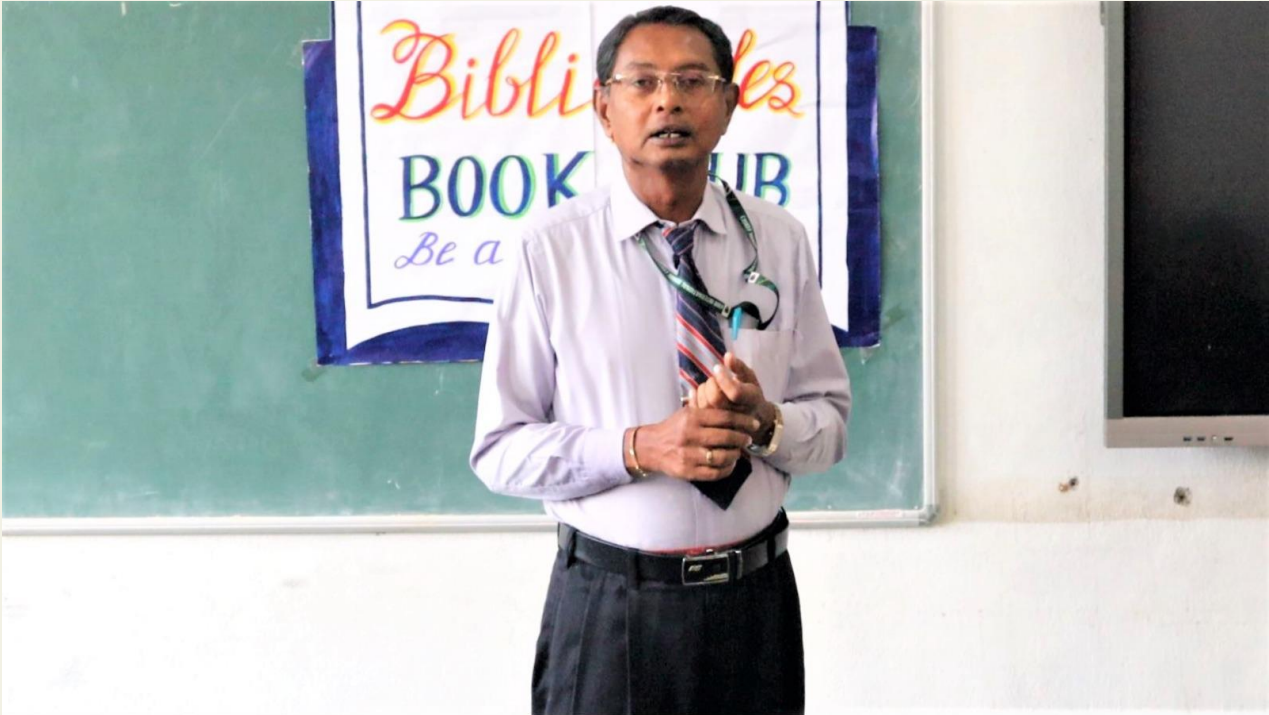


